Another academic year has come to its conclusion and as in other years, it passed quickly. The Development Department at Regis College has taken on a very different orientation since the announcement of the purchase of Christie House. Christie House, located at the corner of Queen's Park Crescent East and Wellesley Street West, will be transformed into the new home of Regis College over the next 18 months. Originally constructed by the founder of Christie Biscuits in the late 19th century, Christie House was recently used as a women's dormitory by St. Michael's College. In September 2009, Christie House will reopen as the new Regis College. Over the next 12 months you will be hearing more about the progress of construction.

Once again, this year benefactors of the College have been extremely generous. Our Annual Fund goal exceeded \$115,000 and our Scholarship Appeal will exceed \$40,000 with the help of the Ontario Trust for Student Support matching contribution. Many other generous benefactors have contributed in special ways toward specific projects, such as our "5 for 5" Advanced Degree Scholarship Appeal, the new St. Joseph Icon Fund, centres of excellence, and academic chairs. As of today, we have raised in excess of \$420,000.

Thank you for your continued interest and concern for Regis College. We benefit from your financial commitment to our mission of educating students for ministry. We are committed to our goal of providing future leaders to the many ministries of the church both here in Canada and around the world.
